

Privacy Notice

Newbury Athletic Club are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. For any personal data you provide for the purposes of your membership, Newbury Athletic Club is the Data Controller and is responsible for storing and otherwise processing that data in a fair, lawful, secure and transparent way.

The Club does not supply any personal data it holds for this purpose to any other third party. The Club does not store or transfer your personal data outside of the UK. The club will store your personal data on a membermojo online manangement software system. You can view and amend your data from your portal. If you have any questions about the continuing privacy of your personal data when it is placed with membermojo, please refer to https://membermojo.co.uk/mm/help/gdpr.

What personal data we hold on you

You may give us information about you by filling in forms at an event or online, or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you register with the Club, subscribe to newsletters, or participate in discussion boards on our website. The information you give us may include your name, date of birth, address, e-mail address, phone number, health data, name of the EA affiliated Clubs with which you are registered and gender (Athletics data).

Why we need your personal data

The reason we need your Athletics Data is to be able to administer your membership and provide the membership services you are signing up to when you register with the club. Our lawful basis for processing your personal data is that we have a contractual obligation to you as a member to provide the services you are registering for.

Reasons we need to process your data include:

For training and competition entry

- sharing personal data with club coaches or officials to administer training sessions;
- sharing personal data with club team managers to enter events;
- sharing personal data with facility providers to manage access to the track or check delivery standards; and
- sharing personal data with leagues, county associations (and county schools' associations) and other competition providers for entry in events.

For funding and reporting purposes


- sharing anonymised data with a funding partner as condition of grant funding e.g. Local Authority;
- analysing anonymised data to monitor club trends; and
- sending club surveys to improve your experience as a club member

For membership and club management

- · processing of membership forms and payments;
- sharing data with committee members to provide information about club activities, membership renewals or invitation to social events;
- · club newsletters promoting club activities; and
- publishing of race and competition results

Marketing and communications

- sending information about promotions and offers from sponsors;
- sending information about selling club kit, merchandise or fundraising.



Any special category health data we hold on you is only processed for the purpose(s) of passing to coaches to allow the safe running of training sessions. We process this data on the lawful basis of consent. Therefore, we will also need your explicit consent to process this data, which we will ask for at the point of collecting it.

On occasion we may collect personal data from non-members (e.g. such as any non-member participant who fills in a health disclaimer or form at a taster session). This information will be stored for up to 12 weeks after an event or taster session and then deleted if the athlete does not become a member of the club. Our lawful basis for processing data is consent. Therefore, we will also need explicit consent from non-members to process this data, which we will verbally ask for at the point of collecting it.

The club has the following social media pages: Facebook (both juniors and seniors) and Twitter. All members are free to join these pages. If you join one of the Social Media pages, please note that provider of the social media platform(s) have their own privacy policies and that the club do not accept any responsibility or liability for these policies. Please check these policies before you submit any personal data on the club social media pages.

When you become a member of the Club you can also choose to be registered as a member of England Athletics Limited when you first compete. If you choose to compete for the club we will register you as a member of England Athletics Limited, and we will provide England Athletics Limited with your Athletics Data which they will use to enable access to the MyAthletics online portal. England Athletics Limited will contact you to invite you to sign into and update your MyAthletics portal. You can set and amend your privacy settings from the MyAthletics portal. If you have any questions about the continuing privacy of your personal data when it is shared with England Athletics Limited, please contact dataprotection@englandathletics.org. If you do not sign up to compete with the club then we will not share your data with England Athletics Limited. Please be aware that should you ever wish to compete in your sport you will have to register with England Athletics Limited at that time.

Photography

From time to time the club may take photographs to include on the club website and/or social media pages. If you do not wish for this to happen please inform the Welfare Officer on welfare@newburyac.org.uk

How long we hold your personal data

We will hold your personal data on file for as long as you are a member with us. Athlete data is updated every year on annual membership forms/renewals. Any personal data we hold on you will be deleted after four years of inactivity on that member's account, in line with England Athletics Limited's retention policy or upon written notification of your retirement from the club. Your data is not processed for any further purposes other than those detailed in this policy.

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject you may have the right at any time to request access to, rectification or erasure of your personal data; to restrict or object to certain kinds of processing of your personal data, including direct marketing; to the portability of your personal data and to complain to the UK's data protection supervisory authority, the Information Commissioner's Office about the processing of your personal data.

As a data subject you are not obliged to share your personal data with the Club. If you choose not to share your personal data with us we may not be able to register or administer your membership.
